<b>Subject: Conflict of Interest</b>	

## **General Requirements**

In the procurement of property and services by the Awardee, the conflict of interest provisions in 24 CFR, Part 85.36 and 24 CFR, Part 84.42, respectively, apply. In all cases not governed by 24 CFR, Part 85.36 and 24 CFR, Part 84.42, the provisions of the 24 CFR, Part 92.356 apply.

No person who exercises or has exercised any function or responsibilities with respect to activities assisted with HOME funds or who are in a position to participate in a decision making process or gain inside information with regard to these activities, may obtain a financial interest or benefit from a HOME-assisted activity or have an interest in any contract, subcontract, or agreement with respect thereto, or the proceeds thereunder, either for themselves or those with whom they have immediate family or business ties, during their tenure or for one (1) year thereafter. Immediate family ties include (whether by blood, marriage or adoption) the spouse, parent (including a stepparent), child (including stepchild), brother, sister (including stepbrother or stepsister), grandparent, grandchild, and in-laws of a covered person.

## **Procedures**

- Awardees must enact application procedures that will expose any conflict of interest.
- OHFA will not grant an exception to the provisions of the requirement in any case.
